

College/University Scholarships

- **University of Alabama**

- **Capstone Scholar**
 - 27 ACT or 1210-1240 SAT and 3.5 GPA or higher.
 - Applicants receive \$1,500 per year.
- **Collegiate Scholar**
 - 28-29 ACT or 1250-1320 SAT and 3.5 GPA or higher.
 - Applicants receive \$3,500 per year.
- **UA Scholar**
 - 30-31 ACT or 1330-1390 SAT and 3.5 GPA or higher.
 - Applicants receive scholarship equal to the value of two-thirds the cost of out of state tuition for four years.
- **Presidential Scholar**
 - 32-36 ACT or 1400-1600 SAT and 3.5 GPA or higher.
 - Applicants receive scholarship equal to the amount of out-of-state tuition for four years.
- **Academic Elite**
 - 32-36 ACT or 1400-1600 SAT and 3.8 GPA or higher.
 - Applicants will be considered for \$8,500 for four years, value of tuition for four years, four years of on-campus housing at regular room rate, AND a lap top computer.
- **National Merit or National Achievement Semifinalist**
 - Value of tuition for four years.
- **National Merit and National Achievement Finalists**
 - Value of tuition for four years, four years of on-campus housing at regular room rate, \$1,000 per year stipend for four years, one-time allowance of \$2,000 for use in summer research or international study, AND a laptop computer.

 - **Awards:** 20 students within top 10% of class to receive renewable scholarship covering undergraduate tuition and fees.
 - **Requirements:** Common Application to BU, essay, and nomination form.

- **Lafayette College Marquis Scholarship**
 - **Award:** Marquis Scholars receive an annual minimum award of \$20,000 (\$80,000 over four years).
 - **Requirements:** No special application. Curriculum, grades, scores on standardized tests are all considered. Scholarship offers are typically made to students who are at the top of their graduating class in the most demanding curriculum available, with SAT scores (Critical Reading and Math) in the low 1400's or better or ACT composite score of 32 or better. Students must maintain a GPA of 3.0
 - **Due Date:** Scholarship recipients are required to file the FAFSA each year in order to determine and maximize federal and/or state eligibility. First year students must file by **January 15**, returning students by April 20.
